Responsibilities/Key Activities

- Monitor technical, regulatory and policy issues that impact the spice industry
- Develop tools and resources to educate the industry on regulatory compliance
- Advise on research related to food safety and technical issues
- Oversee ASTA's advocacy platform
- Develop comments/positions on regulatory issues

Task Forces

- Analytical Methods Subcommittee: reviews, revises, & drafts ASTA's analytical methods (meets quarterly)
- <u>Document Review Subcommittee</u>: keeps ASTA's guidance up-to-date (meets ~1-2 per year)
- Contaminants Task Force: discusses regulatory developments on lead (pb) and other toxic elements (meets ~1-2 per month)
- <u>Microbiology Task Force</u>: develops resources and education on validation for the spice industry (meets quarterly)
- ETO Task Force: advocate on ethylene oxide regulations (meets as needed)
- Regulatory Workshop: Works throughout the spring and summer to identify speakers and topics for the annual Regulatory Workshop
